The Chairman is assisted by officers/staff on honorary basis.

Objective of PMNRF is as follows:

- To provide immediate relief to families of those killed in natural calamities like floods, cyclones, droughts, terrorist violence and earthquakes etc.
- To assist partially to defray the expenses for medical treatment like heart surgery, kidney transplantation, cancer treatment of needy people and acid attack etc. receiving treatment at Government/PMNRF empanelled hospitals.
